The Irish economy shrank 6.1 percent on quarter in the second quarter of 2020, following a revised 2.1 percent fall in the previous period as the impact of the COVID-19 restrictions varied across sectors. Sectors focused on the domestic market experienced significantly lower levels of economic activity namely construction (-38.3 percent) and distribution, transport, hotels and restaurants (-30.3 percent).
