Chapter 13: How Populations Evolve

If p = frequency of the dominant allele (R) and q = frequency of the recessive allele (r), q^2 = frequency of the homozygous recessive genotype = 25%, so q = 50%. Since $p + q = 1$, $p = 50%$. Homozygous dominant (RR) individuals = $p^2 = 25%$ of the population = $(500)(0.25) = 125$ individuals.
